## COVID-SAFE POLICY

(Revised 15 December 2021)

Kenmore Bridge Club takes seriously its duty of care to try to keep its members, volunteers, and officials as safe as possible. The Covid-safe policy of the Club is based on official advice issued by the Queensland Government and advice provided by the Queensland Bridge Association.

Current Covid-safe practices at the Club are:

- On arrival, all members and visitors must sign on with the Club's QR code
- Hand sanitiser is available at each table.

### Vaccination Policy

The Queensland Government has issued guidelines operative from 17 December 2021 which permit only **vaccinated** people to enter certain venues, including Bridge clubs.

Kenmore Bridge Club has resolved that, in keeping with Government and community standards, commencing on 17 December 2021 the Club will only permit people who are vaccinated (meaning that they have received double vaccinations) to attend, or participate in, sessions at its clubhouse or events hosted by the Club.

Proof of vaccination status may be provided by smart phone app or Government issued certificate. Evidence of vaccination status is to be shown to the Director (or nominated Committee member) on arrival. Evidence will only be required to be shown once, and can be provided at any time up to 17 December. Information on vaccination status will be treated as confidential and held on a site with restricted access.

Members who choose not to be vaccinated will be assisted to play on-line.
