- agreed that the treasurer be authorised to establish a direct debit for the payment of \$80 bimonthly for the Telstra internet subscription
- moved a vote of thanks to Andrew Sharp for arranging the Telstra internet connection
- approved the membership of 13 new home members and 3 away members
- considered comparative information on annual membership fees and decided to set full membership fees for 2023 at \$59 for home membership and \$52 for home members with a pensioner discount. All other fees to remain unchanged
- authorised the installation of artificial turf in the outdoor area at a cost not exceeding \$5000
- acknowledged the Roma Visit as an unqualified success.
