Profession of respondents before or after retirement

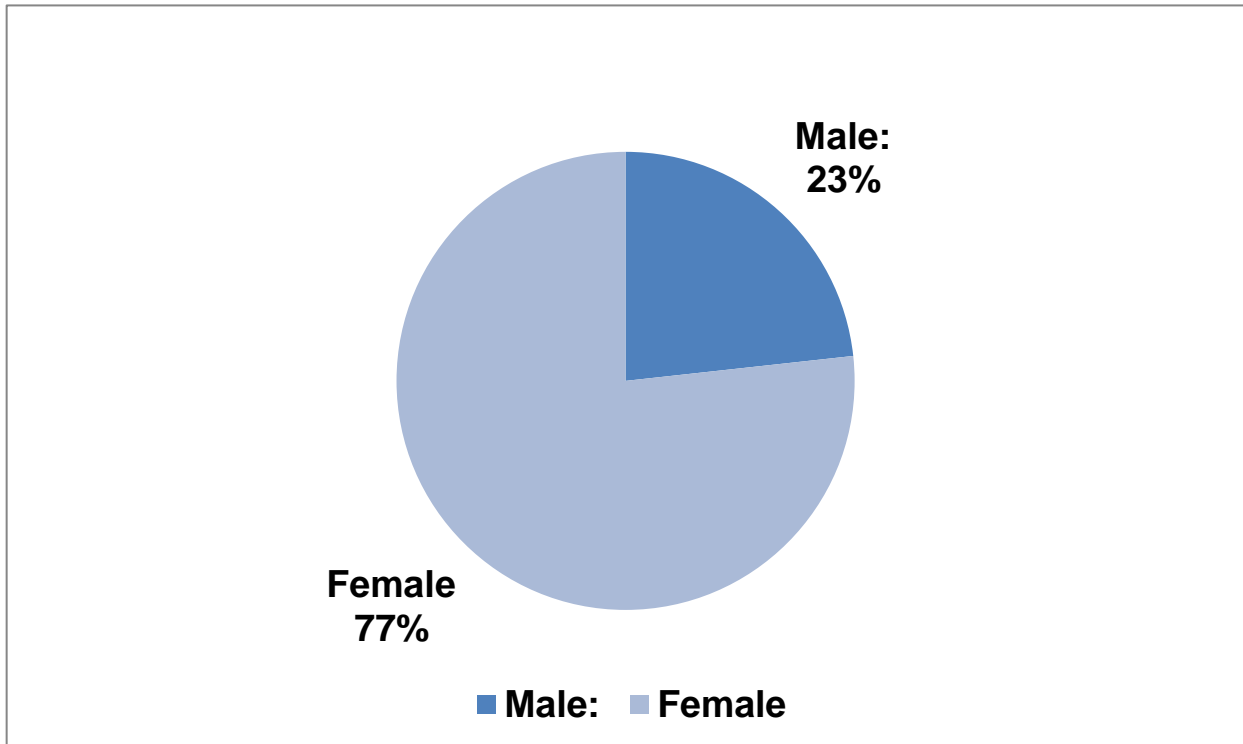

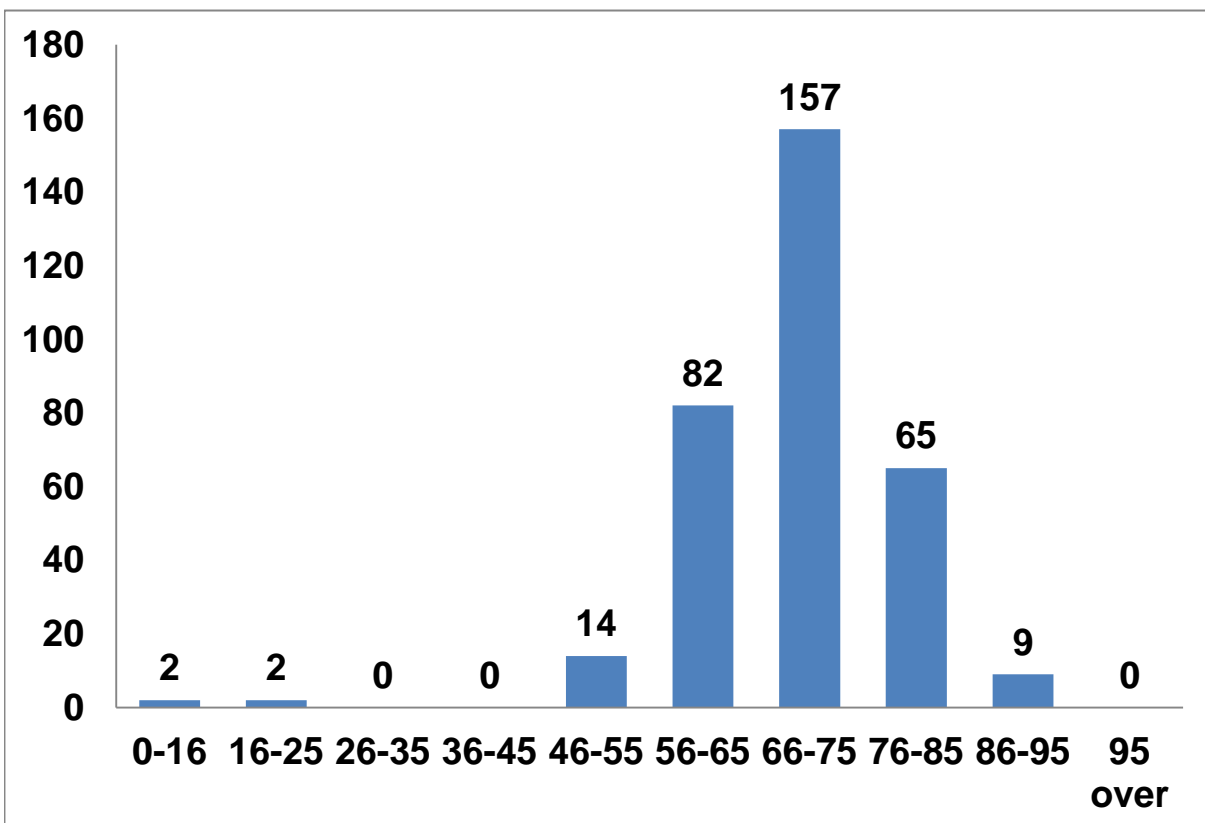

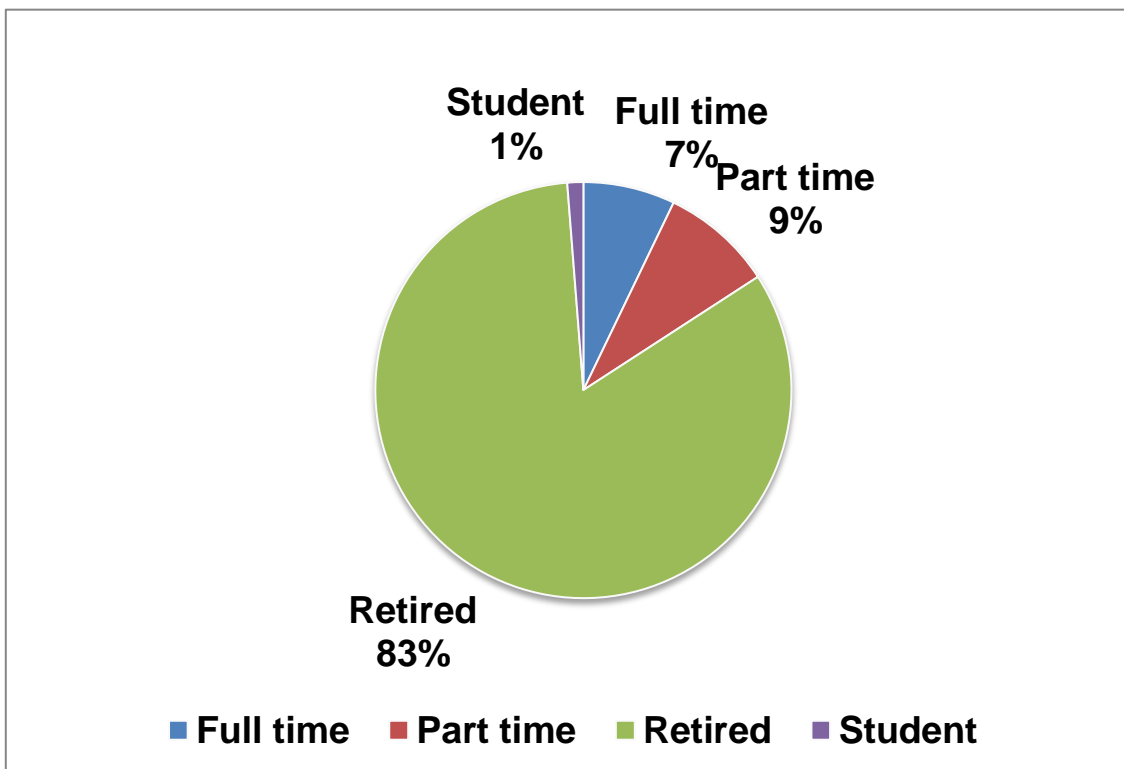
Gender



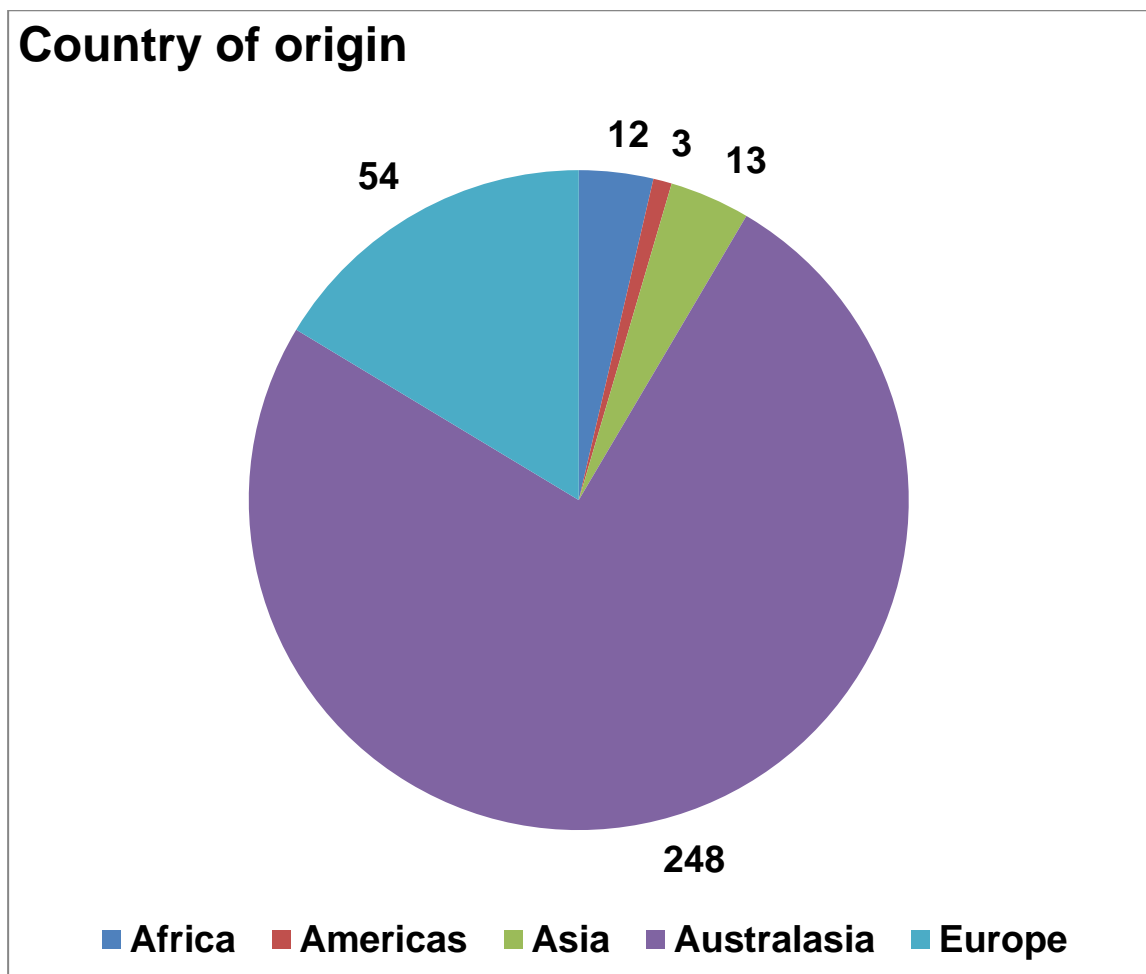
Age Range



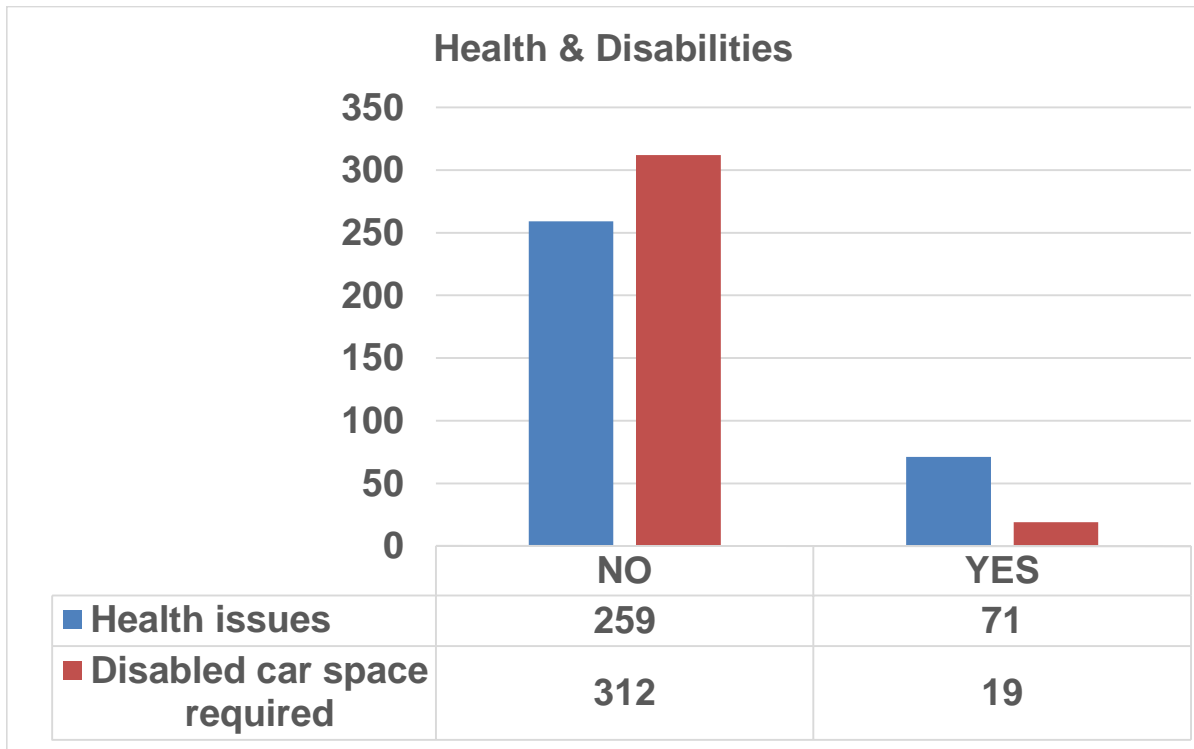
Employment Status



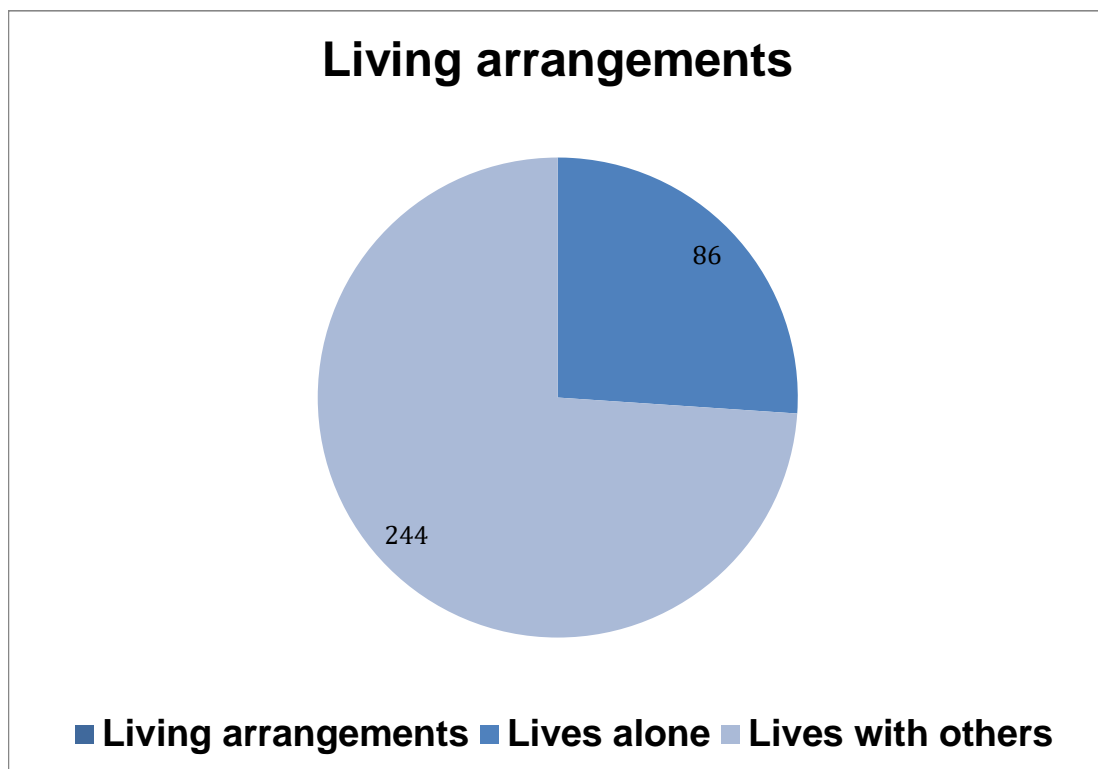

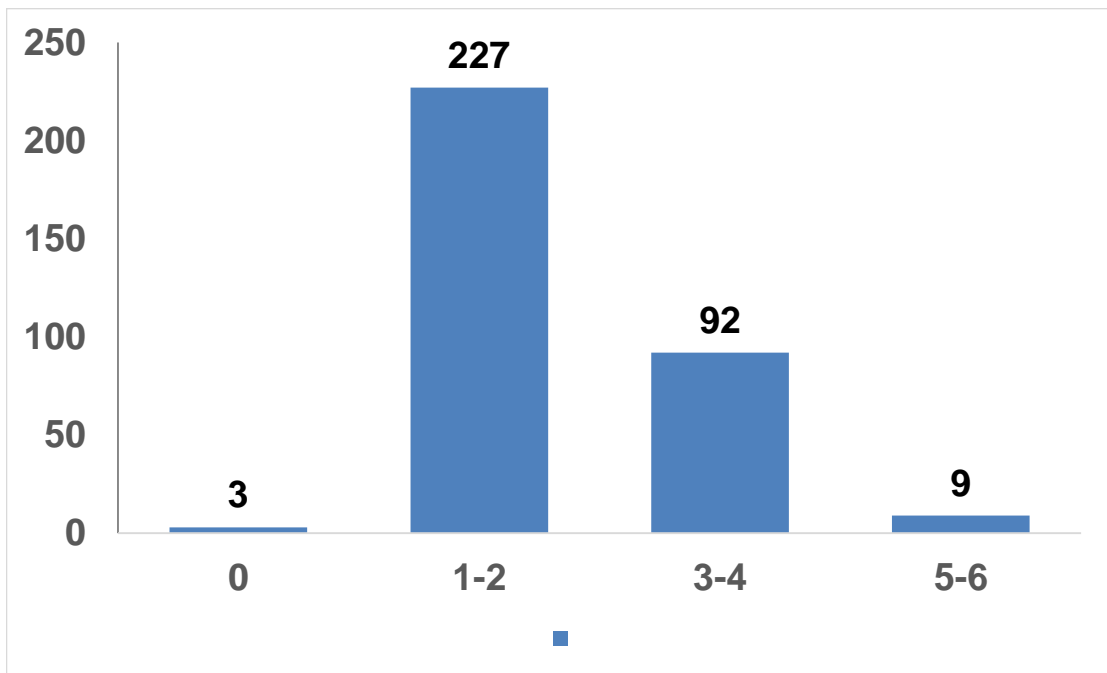
71 respondents reported having serious **health issues** in the past 5 years with 19 reported they require a 'disabled' car parking space



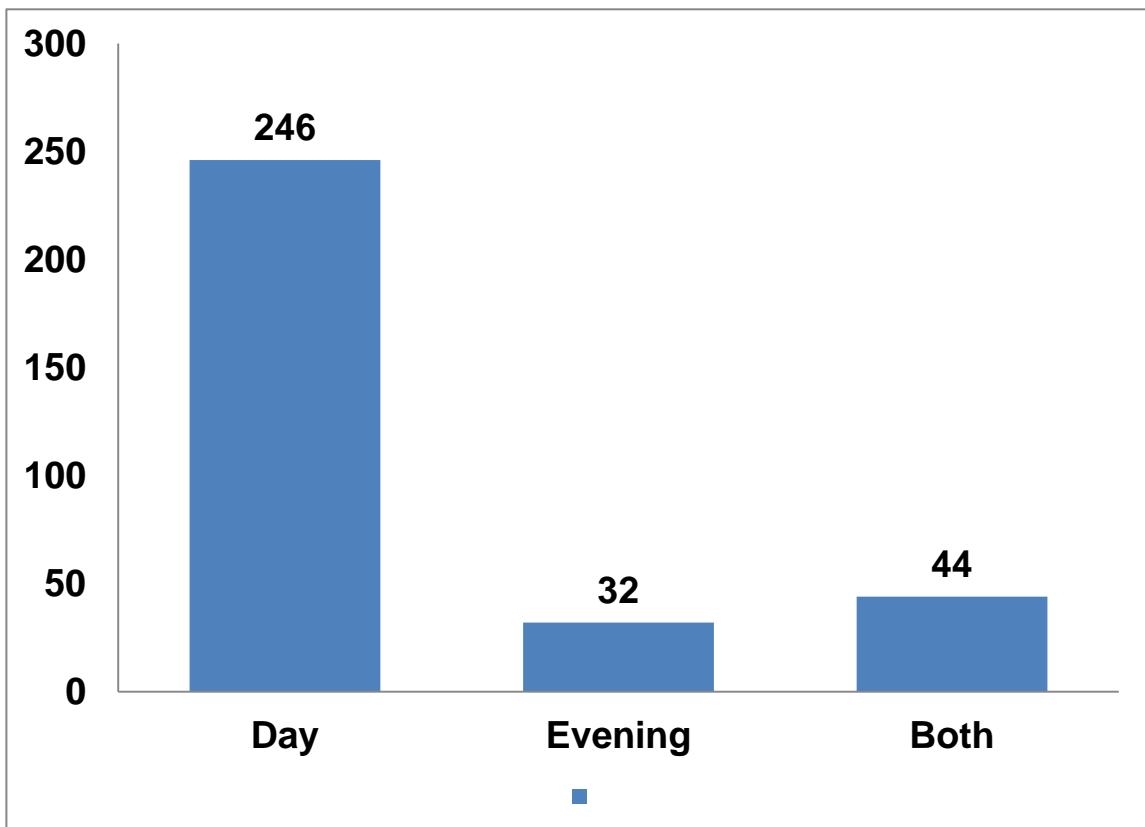
83 members replied that they live alone



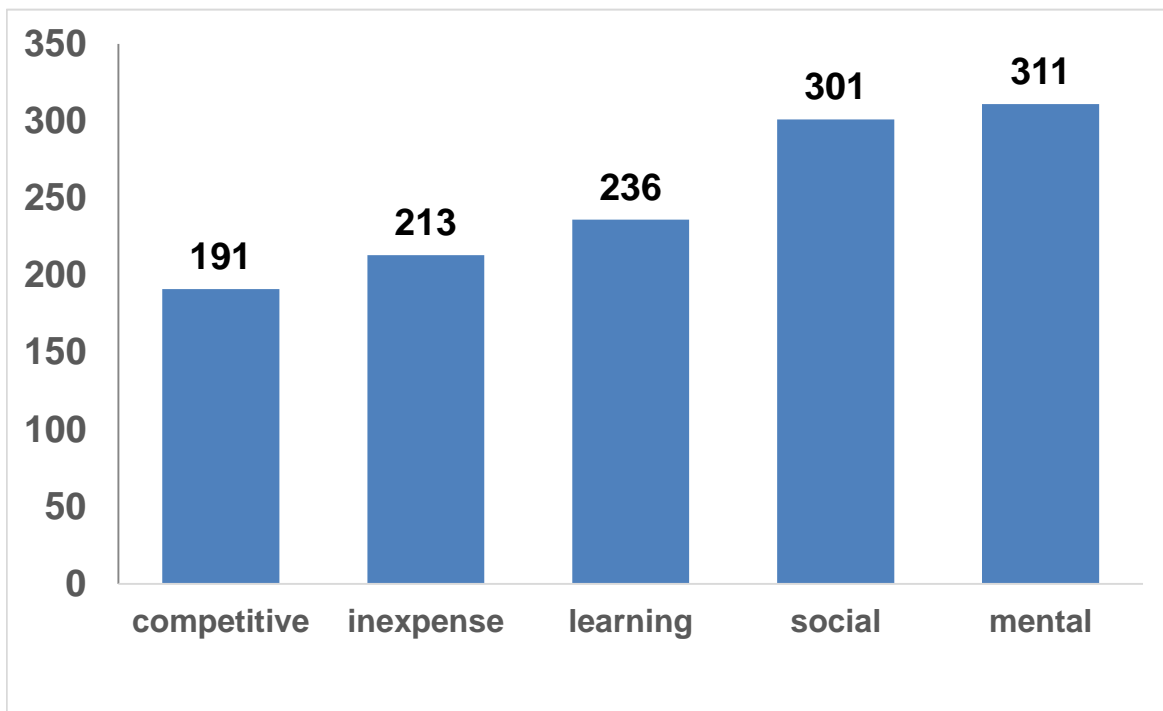
Number of Sessions Members attend each week

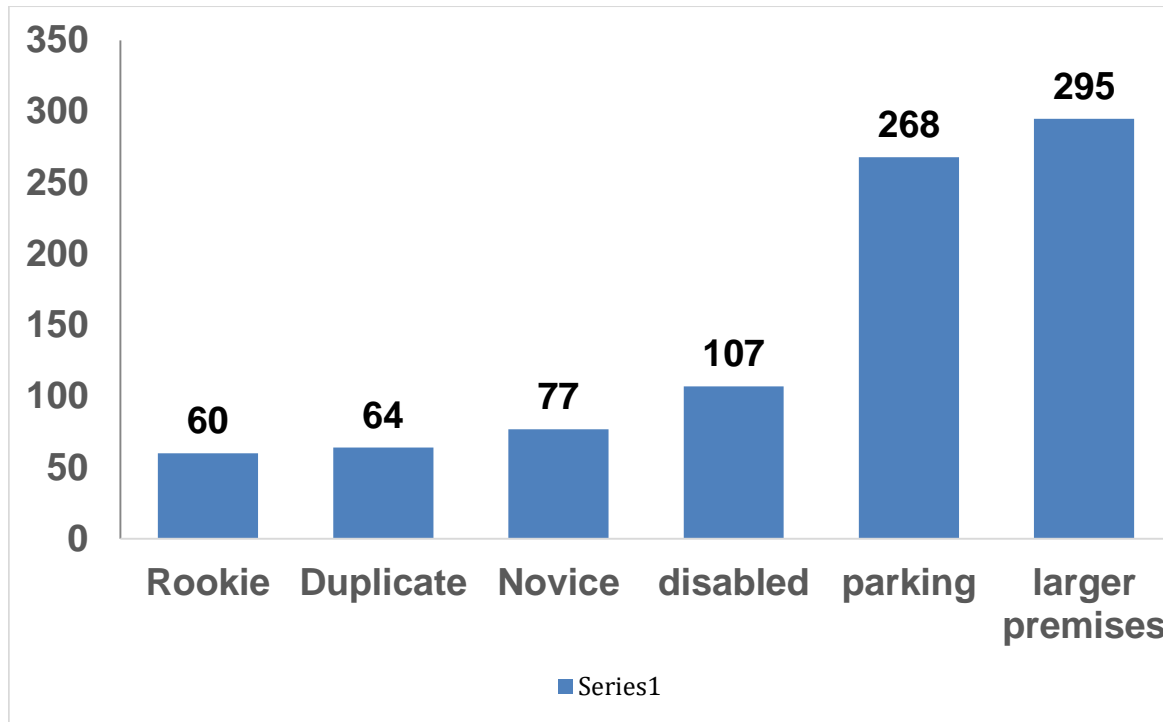
